CHRIST IS HOPE!

Beechpoint creates spaces of safety & belonging for campers in hard places.

We partner with prison, foster, and outreach ministries to identify families in need, and provide continual ministry involvement after camp.

In 2023, 50% of our campers were either **fatherless**, in **foster care**, **adopted**, or had an **incarcerated parent**. Over 35% of our campers came to Camp **faithless** and an even greater number were **churchless**.

Together, we remove barriers!

A variety of barriers make it difficult for under-resourced families to step away from everyday life and into God's peaceful presence at Camp.

Your support reduces the cost of Camp for *every* Camper, and provides additional needbased scholarships to campers in hard places.

Camp Beechpoint is committed to sharing the good news of the gospel with *every* camper.

In 2023, 3 out of every 8 campers in a Cabin was an unbeliever prior to Camp. **71 campers accepted Christ!**

The number of campers that we can serve depends on the number of summer staff we hire. In 2023, we increased summer staff weekly pay to help address the hiring crisis. In 2024, we need 45 young adults to serve at Camp!



LIVES ARE CHANGED!

LEADERS IN TRAINING (LIT)

14 to 17 year olds take their faith to the next level as part of our yearlong LIT program. LITs serve for 4-8 weeks over the summer and return every other month for discipleship.

In 2023, we raised \$30,000 through the *Together, We Can* campaign! LITs are collecting cans through March.



MINISTRY TRAINING (MTP)

5 young adults (18-24yo) live, serve and develop their calling at Camp as part of our 11-month Ministry Training Program. In 2023, we added specialized internship areas, and started paying MTP interns a weekly stipend.

In 2023, over 160 volunteers spent over 1,400 hours helping maintain our **beautiful 100-acre property**, and **state-of-the-art facilities**. When needed, donors generously stepped in and helped fund complex projects. We thank God for you!

BEECHPOINT RANCH

At the Beechpoint Ranch, campers explore how a connection with horses can mirror our connection with Christ!

In addition to horses providing a powerful gospel experience, cabin leaders have shared that their campers are more likely to bond with others after being in the horse arena. Internal walls fall as campers learn to rely on staff for guidance.

In 2023, we expanded our Horse Arena. We also welcomed Barn Manager Rita, Volunteer Anita, & Equine Interns Alison and Emily. With their support, we led horse ministry experiences every week of the summer and throughout the fall.


